ASSASSINATOR reserved after breaking awkwardly, angled outside the leaders in early stretch and rallied under pressure to win going away. WESTERN PRIDE chased the pace three wide into the stretch and proved second best while unable to match strides with the winner. KING'S INTENTIONS hesitated at the start, saved ground around the turn and closed to gain the show. COLEBROOK JET made the pace along the rail to inside the eighth pole and gave way. GATOR'S LADY outrun after hitting the gate at the start, improved his position without threatening. GENERALS SWORD failed to menace. HURRICANE JAKE chased the pace, made a run at the lead outside COLEBROOK JET leaving the turn, then tired in the drive. LUCK'S WAGER was outrun while racing wide. SIGFRETO was never close after breaking poorly and swerving in at the start. CHETSABET showed early foot, then faded while racing four wide around the turn. STAR WITNESS broke slowly and was through early.
