STARS GO BLUE outrun early, rallied four wide on the far turn to gain command, then drew off under a hand ride. PLEASING LOUISE unhurried early, advanced four wide on the far turn, angled to the inside at the top of the stretch and closed to prove second best. STARSHIP DAYDREAM allowed to settle, angled out after entering the stretch and closed to gain the show. GROOM'S KISS raced in striking position into the stretch and tired. SEA CHATTER chased the pace three wide, moved to gain a brief lead on the far turn, then faltered in the drive. RUN BIG saved ground to no avail. SHINING TOWN rated off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn and gave way. GLOOMY KNOT was through early. CUCHU prompted the pace outside SKIP CLASS into the far turn and faded. SKIP CLASS set the pace along the inside into the far turn and stopped.
