REGAL APPROACH rated off the pace, rallied to take over at the eighth pole and drew clear under urging. SO DELICIOUS set the pace along the rail into the stretch but couldn't stay with the winner in the final eighth while clearly best of the rest. AMANJENA reserved early, was saving ground when steadied soon after entering the far turn, eased out for the drive and closed to be up for the show while no threat to the top ones. AZIZA chased the pace along the rail into the far turn and tired. MORALAP was not a factor. THAT'S REAL NICE was outrun. JUST JENN raced in striking position into the far turn, faded and was eased in the final eighth. SNOW GLITTER chased the pace to the far turn, stopped and was eased in the stretch run.
