MALA MALA CAT prompted the pace outside STEPHEN'S TRICK, took over from that rival on the far turn, then shook off a challenge from SUMMER PARTY GIRL and drew clear under urging. OLE RUGGED CROSS rated off the pace after breaking slowly, angled out for the drive and rallied to gain the place. SUMMER PARTY GIRL stalked the pace three wide, made a run on the far turn to try the winner into the stretch but couldn't stay with that rival and gave way in the final eighth. QUEEN'S MANDATE unhurried early, passed tired rivals without threatening. KARATE KING tracked the pace to nearing the stretch, then tired. JK'SJAZZMAN raced in striking position into the far turn, then faltered. STEPHEN'S TRICK set the pace along the inside into the far turn, then faded. MAJOR KEVIN off slowly, was outrun and eased in the final eighth.
