MO'S PRIZE tracked the pace, rallied to take over inside the eighth pole, then edged away. HAPPY HONOREE off slowly, chased the pace three wide around the turn, moved to gain a slim lead in the stretch but was outfinished. BANNER ELK reserved early, swung out for the drive and closed to gain the show. DOUBLE YOUR LUCK showed speed off the rail into the stretch, then weakened. GET ON TRACK pressed the pace along the rail to past midway of the turn, then tired. IRISH CATON was no factor after breaking slowly. DAYUMA was outrun. GO CHELY GO chased the pace to nearing the stretch, then faltered.
