JANE'S HALO unhurried early, rallied around the far turn, angled inside SILVER SCHOLAR for the stretch run and closed to be just up in the final strides. SILVER SCHOLAR bumped with HESPERUS at the start, moved up to chase the pace, took over on the far turn and opened a clear advantage, then drifted out in the stretch and just failed to last. HESPERUS jostled between rivals at the start, chased the pace three wide into the stretch and tired. TINARINA reserved early, saved ground and failed to threaten. SARATOGA SPRING set the pace along the inside into the far turn and tired. LADY KILKEELAN bumped with HESPERUS at the start, tracked the pace three wide into the far turn and faltered. STORMIN JEANNIE checked to avoid running up on heels leaving the first turn and was outrun. PETALS was done early and eased in the stretch run.
