VALENTINE LIGHT vied for the lead along the inside into the far turn, then drew away when set down for the drive. BLESS YOU tracked the pace, raced three wide on the far turn and closed to gain the place while no match for the winner. TIPPERARY MOON well placed while saving ground, couldn't keep pace with the top ones in the drive while closing for the show. BELLA SIGNORA rated in striking position off the pace, had no response in the drive. NITRO SHOCK vied for the lead outside VALENTINE LIGHT into the far turn, then tired. DICENTRA steadied in traffic on the first turn, saved ground and faltered. MYSTIC ILLUSION steadied in behind DICENTRA on the first turn and was not a factor. SAPECA showed little.
