Footnotes

PAMPERED KING maintained good position inside, started a drive entering the stretch and came between horses in deep stretch to take over nearing the wire. KHUKURI rated with the pace off the rail while alternating for control most of the backstretch, drifted outward in the upper stretch, recovered stride to take a short brief lead past the sixteenth pole then outfinished the final yards while besting the pacesetter for place. SAILORS SONG rated a clear lead inside the opening turn, meted his speed to retain slim control down the backstretch, dug in close through the upper stretch then yielded the closing yards. BRADY THOMAS settled back about the three path, bid into the final turn and finished well. BOBS TIEBREAKER broke in possibly brushing the gate, rated off the pace about the three path, advanced to threatening position near the half mile pole then leveled off in the lane. OSAGE was closest the opening eighth and never threatened. TEXAS HEDGE broke out then saved ground. NAILED, pinched back at the start, never factored.
