FOR MARIMAR unhurried after breaking slowly, rallied along the rail to gain the lead approaching the sixteenth pole, then drew clear. BOOGIE WOOGIE reserved off the pace, angled out for the stretch run and finished willingly to be up for the place. BEAT THE BLUES allowed to settle after breaking poorly, swung out for the stretch run and closed to be up for the show. ROSALINDA chased the pace three wide into the stretch and gave way. LOITA chased the pace into the stretch and tired. WHY I LOVE YOU showed speed off the rail to nearing the sixteenth pole, then had nothing left. JEANNIE S raced four wide and faltered. PRINCESS GRACE chased the pace into the stretch and faded. TOWN PARTS off slowly, trailed.
