VARITEK quickly moved to the fore, made the pace along the inside into the stretch, then was fully extended to hold sway. BARBARO'S REVENGE reserved off the pace, steadied and bumped with MR. SLUGGO on the first turn, raced three wide around the far turn and rallied for the place. MR. SLUGGO steadied in the early going, then was bumped by BARBARO'S REVENGE on the first turn, saved ground around the far turn, angled out in the stretch and closed with a mild response to be up for the show. PRECIOUS BEANS unhurried early, improved his position in the drive without threatening. MARSHMELLOW MAN chased the winner to nearing the stretch, then gave way. SAILORS SONG rated off the pace, made a three wide around the far turn to reach the attending position, then tired in the drive. SWINGMAN well placed while saving ground, faltered in the drive. VINI VIDI VINCI dwelt at the start and was never a factor. GONE STRAIGHT tracked the pace to the far turn, then faded. CRACKLIN steadied from inside BARBARO'S REVENGE on the first turn and was done early.
