#### Footnotes

HONEST EXPECTATION vied for the lead along the inside, drifted out at the top of the stretch and drew clear under urging. FLASHING FLAME unhurried early, saved ground into the stretch, eased out and rallied to be up for the place. SERVICE HAWK reserved off the pace, closed with a mild response to gain the show. CLEVER CHIEF vied for the lead between horses to nearing the stretch, then gave way. SUPER STRUGGLER ducked out at the start, raced with the pace four wide around the turn and tired. TRUE LEGACY vied for the lead three wide to past midway of the turn, then faltered. DEREK'S CADILLAC rated off the pace after being caught in tight at the start, faded leaving the turn. RUBBER BUCKY reared and bucked at the start unseating his rider.
