Footnotes

CANCERBERO rated off the pace, angled to the inside on the far turn, rallied to catch THE CAT RULES just inside the eighth pole and was all out to prevail. THE CAT RULES set the pace off the rail to past the eighth pole, then couldn't stay with the winner while clearly best of the others. BABYLON RICH stalked the pace, advanced three wide to reach the attending position on the far turn, then weakened in the drive. EVIL POWDER reserved early, made a run four wide on the far turn to loom a threat, then tired. MOUNT SKYLIGHT stalked the pace along the inside, then was faltering when his rider lost his whip in the stretch. WILD RATE raced four wide and never threatened. EL COBRE failed to menace. CELLARS CABERNET unhurried early, steadied in traffic on the far turn and was not a factor. EL TABRAWY pressed the early pace, then couldn't stay with THE CAT RULES down the backstretch and faded on the far turn.
