BUILDING A MYSTERY showed speed racing off the rail, edged clear leaving the turn and remained clear to the wire under pressure. PRETTY WOMEN well placed racing off the rail, closed to prove second best. INVOICE allowed to settle, raced four wide around the turn and proved best of the rest. CANNON WHIRL unhurried early, raced five wide on the turn and failed to threaten. DELIGHTFUL BREEZE was steadied when she broke in at the start, moved up to chase the pace three wide around the turn and tired. NEVER MISS showed speed along the rail, then checked on the turn and faded.
