**SOLDIER OF FAME** bumped at the start, raced well back for a half, circled five wide while rapidly gaining on the turn, made a run to challenge in midstretch then ducked in after taking the lead bothering **SABRE BABY** in deep stretch. Following a stewards inquiry along with a claim of foul by the rider of **SABRE BABY**, **SOLDIER OF FAME** was disqualified from first and placed second for interference in deep stretch. **SABRE BABY** bumped at the start, raced between horses along the backstretch, circled five wide on the turn, took the lead in upper stretch, steadied along the inside in deep stretch the yielded late. **THE PENNY DROPS** reserved for a half, moved into contention on the turn, made a run to threaten in upper stretch, checked in midstretch then weakened. **STORM BULL** improved his position with a mild late rally. **EL SEGUNDO JOE** forced the pace from outside to the turn and weakened. **ESTABLISHMENTCREEK** raced well back to the turn then rallied belatedly in the middle of the track. **TRI PHAILME** was never a factor. **LIKELY SUSPECT** showed only brief speed. **JOHN'S MECKE** raced up close while five wide to the far turn and gave way. **DE LA MOTHE** set the pace along the rail to the turn

and faltered. ZUMBAFIZZ never reached contention. P. D. BUCKY steadied in traffic on the first turn and failed to threaten thereafter.
