ALIX M stalked the pace while three wide along the backstretch, made a run from outside to challenge at the quarter pole, surged to the front inside the furlong marker then edged clear under intermittent urging. D' WILDCAT SPEED prompted the pace between horses for a half, gained a slim lead at the top of the stretch, battled into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. SLEWS FINAL ANSWER settled in good position along the rail for a half, angled four wide leaving the turn then finished willingly in the middle of the track to gain a share. SPECIAL REPORT raced in the middle of the pack along the backstretch, circled five wide leaving the turn then rallied mildly from outside. CRAFTY BRAT was outrun for a half, rallied mildly in the two path leaving the turn then lacked a strong closing bid. HONEYMOONER raced within striking distance while four wide to the top of the stretch and lacked a further response. REALLY ROYAL failed to threaten while four wide. MIRACLE RUNNER set he pace along the rail for a half and gave way. SILVER LACE was never a factor after being pinched back at the start.
