A LITTLE HALO JOY chased LUCKY TO COPE into the stretch and wore that rival down to be just up at the wire. LUCKY TO COPE sprinted to a clear lead along the rail, made the pace to deep stretch but couldn't hold off the winner in the final strides. GOTTA BIN TO WIN chased the leaders into the stretch and closed the gap on those rivals through the final eighth. BAND DIXIE rated off the pace after breaking slowly, closed with a belated rally. CORRYVILLE reserved off the pace, raced three wide on the turn and had no response when asked. SUNSHINE NUMBERS failed to menace. CASH AND RUN was not a factor after breaking awkwardly. THAT BEAU CAN RUN off slowly, was saving ground when steadied entering the turn and never threatened. DANCER OSCAR allowed to settle, lacked a rally. TACTFUL PRINCE was outrun.
