LOVERBIL unhurried early, swung out for the stretch run, then rallied to take over nearing the sixteenth pole and edged away. MORADOR LLERS (ARG) outrun after being steadied soon after the start, swung wide for the stretch run and rallied for the place while unable to get to the winner. MALIBU WAVE rated off the pace after breaking slowly, advanced to loom a threat in midstretch but was outfinished. WILD ALLEY CAT vied for the early lead, dropped back around the turn, came back on to reach near even terms for command at the eighth pole, then tired. EL KIWI was not a factor. SWIDGEN vied for the lead outside WILD ALLEY CAT, edged away from that rival on the turn, maintained his advantage to nearing the sixteenth pole, then faltered. SERAPI CAT was outrun. STARSHIP TITAN reserved off the pace, faded in the drive.
