MEGAN SPRING ROSE advanced four wide around the turn, rallied to take over nearing the sixteenth pole and drew clear. ON A WHIRL bumped with MISS RUDI at the start, set the pace under pressure along the inside and saved the place while unable to stay with the winner in the final sixteenth. JEANNIE G. chased the pace three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed late response. FRAULIEN RUCKUS allowed to settle, swung out for the stretch run and passed tired rivals. EXTRAVAGANT LADY forced the pace outside ON A WHIRL to midstretch and weakened. ELO'S CREEK saved ground around the turn and lacked a rally. MARCI'S BABY was no factor after being outrun early. QUIBBLE'S REVENGE showed early foot along the rail and tired. MISS RUDI bumped with ON A WHIRL at the start, chased the pace into the stretch and faltered. BLUE BALLETT was outrun. SWUNG showed little.
