Footnotes

AMELIA steadied when STAFINA came out on the first turn, raced four wide on the far turn and rallied under pressure to be up in the final strides. SARA'S SUCCESS well placed while saving ground, slipped through along the hedge and gained a slim lead inside the sixteenth pole, then just failed to last. ING ING (FR) unhurried while saving ground, steadied soon after entering the far turn, angled out for the drive and made a run at the leaders but didn't do enough late. GUILLOTINE outrun early, raced three wide on the far turn, then finished willingly between rivals. SHOOTING PARTY set the pace along the inside to deep stretch and gave way. PLATINUM TIARA chased the pace to inside the eighth pole and weakened. IRISH FANTASY tracked the leaders three wide into the stretch and tired. SALTY YOU rated in striking position off the pace, lacked a rally. STARBOARD STINGER failed to menace. STAFINA checked on the first turn, then was no factor while saving ground. FIDDLE raced five wide on the far turn and was outrun. CURIOUS CONUNDRUM chased the leaders four wide into the far turn and faded.
