Footnotes

GREAT VICTORIAN showed speed along the inside, drew clear around the turn and into the stretch, then was all out to hold sway. STRONG FIRE reserved off the pace after being bumped between rivals at the start, angled out for the stretch run and rallied to be just up for the place. BASALT stalked the pace, eased three wide leaving the turn, then rallied while just being edged for the place. LARGE KAUFY unhurried early, raced three wide around the turn, swung out widest of all for the stretch run and rallied to just miss the show. DUBAI DISTINCTION pressed the early pace, chased the winner into the stretch and was outfinished. LANCE'S SONG allowed to settle after being steadied when he bumped with STRONG FIRE at the start, raced along the inside and gained some ground without really threatening. HONOR'S GOLD stalked the pace along the inside into the stretch but had no response when asked. PURELY PRECIOUS steadied when he bumped with STRONG FIRE at the start and trailed.
