Footnotes

ROYAL KISS raced between horses around the second turn, moved up with a drive along the rail and drew off. BRANT POINT stalked the leaders from the outside, advanced three wide around the second turn and finished well. JACK'S TOUCH in hand three wide around the first turn, narrowed the gap nearing the stretch, took command in upper stretch and was outgained to the wire. PEACE ROSE raced unhurried in the early stages, raced four wide entering the stretch and finished evenly. CALLING NICOLE four wide early, moved out to race for or six wide in the stretch while not a factor. TRULY A SAINT set easy pace along the rail, gave ground nearing the turn and faded. NOBLE BALLET contested the pace from just outside, took lead near the five-eighths pole and tired.
