HOPE AND LUCK chased the pace four wide, lost ground leaving the turn but closed steadily to get up the final strides. CATCH THE BEAT, unhurried early inside, improved her position at the rail through the turn, eased three wide for the drive home, dug in from there and was just up for place under the wire. FANDANGLE hustled to the lead for inside position and slim control, was pressured into the stretch then outfinished for place while under a steady drive. PRECIOUS LADY chased the pace two deep and continued a close factor in the upper stretch before flattening stride a furlong away. OUR PEE CHEE showed no early speed inside, eased to the four path through the turn and finished well. OMI'S VINDICATION chased the early pace three wide, lost some ground through the turn, entered the stretch five wide and leveled off. ALSAREI, edgy at the gate, lacked speed down the backstretch, came through the turn about the five path and had no rally. SHES LIGHTNIN steadied early at the inside flank of Fandangle, chased the pace through the backstretch, was in tight at the rail approaching the quarter pole then faded through the lane.
