AWE THAT chased the pace, moved to gain a slim lead leaving the turn but was no match for the winner while saving the place. LUCETTE reserved early, angled out in the stretch and closed to just miss the place. HIDDEN CREEK chased the pace, angled three wide on the turn to make a run at the lead in the stretch, then tired. HAZINO bumped with MORNING SUN early and failed to menace. MISS ANNIE BEA was outrun. FLYING BIRDIE showed speed along the inside and faded.
