LICENSE TO SPEED rated while saving ground, was forced to wait for room leaving the far turn, angled out and rallied to take over at the eighth pole, then drew clear under a strong hand ride. SMOOTH N EASY under restraint while in tight quarters in the early going, saved ground into the stretch, was forced to steady in behind the leaders in midstretch, angled out and finished willingly for the place. SOME CURVES outrun early, raced four wide on the far turn and closed with a belated rally to just miss the place. NURSE MARGARET stalked the pace, made a run at the lead racing into the stretch, then weakened in the drive. RUNAWAY CHAMP set the pace along the rail into the stretch and gave way. MISS TOPAZ failed to menace. SINN FREE chased the pace into the far turn and tired. BOYSINTHEWOODS unhurried early, swung wide for the stretch run and lacked a rally. RENEE'S APPROVAL showed little. P. J.'S DAY tracked the pace three wide to nearing the stretch and faded.
