Footnotes

TALENTED PRINCE raced in good position for five furlongs, launched a bid three wide on the turn, angled out in upper stretch then closed steadily to wear down HAL'S IMAGE in the final twenty yards. HAL'S IMAGE prompted the early pace in the two path, gained on the turn, surged to the front nearing the quarter pole, continued on the front into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. CASEY'S BISCUIT set the pace along the rail to the turn and steadily tired thereafter. MARNESIA BOY trailed for a half, advanced four wide on the turn, then failed to threaten while improving his position. MONSTER AFFAIR, up close early, failed to mount a serious rally. CHAMPAGNE BRUNCH raced up close for six furlongs and gave way on the turn.
