Footnotes

YOUNGOTTALOVEME, unhurried while saving ground, angled out to start a bid into the final turn, angled widest leaving the quarter pole, surged to the lead while bearing inward and making solid contact with Manifest Destiny in midstretch then drew clear while continuing to drift inward. KARMANOS rated close off the rail, steadied between horses while at the heels of Bizet into the final turn, angled three wide into the lane, was shut off in midstretch, altered course from there then dueled for place while unable to catch the errant winner. MANIFEST DESTINY was checked angling to the outside leaving the first turn, settled back widest on the backstretch, advanced toward contention five wide on the final turn, was bumped off stride in midstretch then outfinished for place. IL TERRAZZO rated off the pace and off the rail, was boxed through the final turn but finished well when clear. BIZET rated a short lead two deep, contested the rail on the final turn and remained a close factor to midstretch before weakening. CHAPEL RUN rated close four wide, took aim approaching the final turn, contested two deep through the turn then weakened inside the eighth pole. TACTICAL LIGHT rated off the pace toward the outside, bid mildly on the final turn, steadied at the heels of Chapel Run into the lane and gave way from there. TRUST THE DEPUTY rated close inside, lost momentum at the flanks of Karmanos into the final turn and gave way. After posting the inquiry and reviewing a claim of foul against the winning rider, lodged by the rider of the third place finisher, the stewards disqualified the winner and placed him third for interference in midstretch.
