Footnotes

ZUBER lacked significant early speed in mid track, improved his position five wide through the turn, came inside the drifting pacesetter midstretch, reached the lead just past the sixteenth pole and was drawing away approaching the wire. D' DREAM came away sharply with an early lead and inside position to set a pressured pace off the rail, lost some ground leaving the quarter pole, dueled in an outward drift through the stretch and yielded inside the sixteenth pole. DISTINCTIVE DAN hesitated several lengths at the start, picked up the chase from the back of the pack, improved position three wide through the turn and finished well considering his earlier deficit. ELEGANT STRAIGHT chased the early pace toward mid track, saved ground while advancing through the turn but leveled off in the stretch. PETER BOY chased the pace about the three path, took aim midway on the turn but flattened stride in the lane. TROOPER DAVE showed no early speed off the rail, eased out entering the stretch though weakened from there. COUNTY TRICK was hustled toward contention inside to press the pace, faded nearing the quarter pole then gave way in the stretch. FINAL PRAYER chased the pace off the rail to the three eighths pole then faded through the turn. WINDY CITY JULE showed no speed outside. HOMBRE OSCURO showed only brief speed before fading.
