SURE SUCCESS advanced along the rail for the lead passing the five eighths pole, set a well managed pace to the top of the lane, was prompted for run from that point and showed willing response to steady encouragement. DANCE FLOOR MANIAC, shuffled back early, settled back off the rail, came between horses in the upper stretch and dug in for place later yards. AIRCRAFT INTERCEPT was hustled with the early pace three deep and between horses, continued close chase on the turn then finished evenly while outfinished for place in late yards. CASINO GAMBLER showed no early speed inside, closed toward contention nearing the turn, had aim at the top of the stretch though leveled off the final furlong. BOURBON TRAIL rated off the pace outside, made a five wide bid on the turn then flattened stride inside the sixteenth pole. FORTY THIEVES had a slim brief early lead four wide near the five eighths pole and remained a close factor through the turn, steadied in the upper stretch, angled out a furlong away and weakened from there. BLUE LION lacked speed well back. MOON NISTLE raced with the pace two deep while between horses, gave chase through the turn but gave way from the quarter pole.
