STEPHEN'S GOLD reserved off the pace, swung out for the stretch run and rallied to be up late. INDY KINGS DANCER stalked the pace, angled out for the stretch run, rallied to gain the lead at the sixteen pole but couldn't resist the winner. NATIVE DOOD set the pace along the inside to the sixteenth pole, then weakened. COMPRISE unhurried early, advanced along the rail into the stretch to loom a threat but couldn't sustain his bid. SIR DANDY ANDY rated off the pace, swung out for the stretch run and lacked a rally. EXCALIBUR chased the pace, made a run to try the leader leaving the far turn to inside the eighth pole, then gave way. HE'S A BIG DADDY trailed.
