Footnotes

LEDOKOL vied for the early lead, was outmoved by FULL RIDE around the first turn, chased that rival, then came on again to take over leaving the quarter pole and was all out to prevail. CARSON CITY BREW reserved off the pace, rallied to loom a threat in midstretch, then was gaining slowly on the winner at the finish. CHEVRON LIGHT rated off the pace after breaking slowly, made a run three wide to join the leaders on the far turn, then weakened in the drive. ROCKITUDE allowed to settle, swung out while advancing into contention on the far turn but couldn't sustain his bid. FULL RIDE off slowly, rushed up three wide around the first turn to gain the lead, opened a commanding advantage while easing to the inside on the backstretch, made the pace to the quarter pole, then tired. BACK TO VALUES tracked the pace along the inside into the stretch and faltered. KAT'S CORINTHIAN was not a factor. FERRARI ONE was done early and eased in the stretch run.
