Footnotes

CLASSIC EXAMPLE stalked the pace three wide, moved to take over on the far turn, opened a clear lead, then responded when challenged at the sixteenth pole and edged away late to prevail. RUNAWAY KITTEN allowed to settle, angled in for the stretch run, made a run along the rail to reach the leader at the sixteenth pole but was outgamed to the wire. CHRISSEY JAY steadied in behind NEIGH HIGHS on the first turn, slipped through inside that rival to gain the lead leaving the first turn, made the pace along the rail to midway of the far turn and gave way. NEIGH HIGHS showed speed off the rail, was outmoved by CHRISSEY JAY leaving the first turn, came on again to reach even terms for command on the far turn, then tired. I'VE GOT TO WIN up close early, faltered leaving the far turn. PENNANT DANCER turned in a dull effort.
