Footnotes

FORMAL MISS unhurried early, raced four wide on the far turn and rallied under pressure to be up late. OUR EXPLOIT broke to the inside, set the pace along the rail to deep stretch but couldn't resist the winner in the closing strides. FAR AFIELD steadied in behind OUR EXPLOIT at the start, tracked the pace along the rail into the stretch but didn't do enough late. UNHURRIED raced in striking position into the stretch and lacked a late response. PATTIANO tracked the pace three wide into the far turn, then gave way. MARCHING RHYTHM chased the pace into the far turn and tired.
