SHES TRIPPIN NORTH showed speed off the rail, veered out when struck left-handed at the top of the stretch, was straightened and drew off under urging. DEVILISH SILVER chased the winner three wide into the stretch but was no match for that rival while clearly second best. DIBS ON DEBBIE outrun early, swung wide for the stretch run and gained the show while never a threat to the top ones. SPEED ANGEL tracked the leaders along the rail to nearing the stretch, then tired. REQUITAL well placed early, faltered. NORMA CLAIRE was not a factor. LET'S GO OUT WEST showed little. LIL LINDA chased the leaders three wide to the turn, then faded.
