SUMMER MIST unhurried after being steadied at the start, was steadied again leaving the far turn, angled out for racing room and closed with a rush to be up in time. SHINGALANA stalked the pace, moved to gain command approaching the eighth pole, drifted out briefly nearing the sixteenth pole and just failed to last. HOW CAN THAT BE chased the pace three wide, then was making a run at SHINGALANA when that rival drifted nearing the sixteenth pole, steadied briefly, then continued on gamely while being outfinished. DAISY O' CURL well placed, came between horses in the drive but didn't do enough late. RUNAWAY RUNNER chased the pace into the stretch and weakened. FLYING IMPETUS set the pace along the inside into the stretch and tired. CUTIE PATOOTIE steadied when caught in tight early, then saved ground and lacked a late response. LADY DHARLY was outrun while racing three wide.
