MISS DELIA rated off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn, rallied to catch UNHURRIED at the sixteenth pole and edged away. UNHURRIED vied for the lead along the inside, responded when challenged by MISS DELIA, then couldn't match strides with that rival late while holding the place. EXCLUSIVE DEPOSIT unhurried early, swung out for the stretch run and rallied to be up for the show. EXCELLENT IDEA tracked the pace along the rail, was forced to wait for racing room in behind the pacesetter leaving the far turn, eased out in the stretch and had no response when asked. MISS BONN BONN tracked the pace, angled out leaving the far turn and lacked a rally. SOME CURVES reserved in striking position along the inside, steadied entering the far turn, then tired in the drive. GO HELEN GO off slowly, was not a factor. MS. RAPUNZEL vied for the lead outside UNHURRIED, then faltered in the drive. DONDE ESTARAS was done early. GROOM'S KISS allowed to settle, raced three wide on the far turn, faded and was eased in the final eighth.
