PORTAFORTUNA pressed the pace outside REGAL ADVANTAGE, gained command from that rival on the turn, then drew off when asked. SOARING STORM was steadied in traffic on the backstretch, chased the pace into the stretch, then couldn't stay with the winner while clearly best of the rest. CRIMSON MAPLE unhurried after breaking slowly, passed tired rivals for the show. QUIET QUEEN tracked the pace around the turn and tired. TOP LIMIT hesitated at the start, tracked the pace three wide around the turn and faltered. REGAL ADVANTAGE set the pace under pressure along the rail into the turn, then faded.
