B L'S A RUNNER chased the winner into the stretch but couldn't get to that rival while proving second best. SAFE PLAY chased the pace along the inside into the stretch and gave way. VILLAINAGE saved ground to no avail. NO MORE MASTERS rated off the pace, tired in the drive. JABBOK raced three wide and faltered.
