Footnotes

SCOTTYS PISTOL unhurried early, swung out for the stretch run, rallied to gain the lead approaching the sixteenth pole and drew clear. SCORPIO RISING rated off the pace, steadied in behind the leaders at the eighth pole, found room and split rivals to gain the place. MANDATE IMAGE vied for the lead along the rail to nearing the sixteenth pole, then gave way. I'M PUZZLED chased the pace, made a run four wide to join the leaders on the far turn, then tired in the drive. SILVER NUGGET reserved racing along the rail, was caught in tight on the backstretch and failed to menace. TWENTY FOR TEN bobbled at the start, moved up to vie for the lead three wide around the far turn and into the stretch, then faltered in the final sixteenth. MASTER TASSEL broke a step slowly, vied for the lead between horses to inside the eighth pole, then faded.
