A. P. EDDIE chased the pace, moved up to vie for the lead with UNIQUE AFLEET around the far turn, bumped with that rival entering the stretch, edged clear, then was fully extended to prevail. BLACK SPOT reserved off the pace, rallied to be up for the place. UNIQUE AFLEET chased the pace, moved up to vie for the lead outside A. P. EDDIE around the far turn, then bumped with that rival racing into the stretch and gave way. HOLIDAY BLAKE outrun after breaking slowly, passed tired rivals in the drive. OFFICER'SGENTLEMAN rated off the pace, was checked to avoid running up on rivals on the far turn and never threatened. CAIXA ELETRONICA allowed to settle, made a run three wide on the far turn to loom a threat, then tired in the drive. GOODTOGOAGAIN vied for the lead outside SIPHON CITY into the far turn, then faltered and was eased late. SIPHON CITY vied for the lead along the inside into the far turn, then faded and was eased in the final eighth.
