### Footnotes

PROSPECT OF LOVE stalked the pace along the hedge, was steadied waiting for room in behind UNFAIR on the far turn, slipped through inside that rival at the top of the stretch and drew clear under urging. SURVICAT unhurried after being steadied from close quarters soon after the start, steadied again in traffic on the far turn, swung out for the stretch run and rallied to be up for the place. DECISIVE BLOW outrun early, rallied four wide to reach the leaders on the far turn, then gave way in the drive. PRIMETIME PRINCESS reserved after being steadied when she bumped with FLORIDA GAL entering the first turn, saved ground and passed tired rivals. VALENTINE LIGHT chased the pace three wide, gained slim lead between rivals on the far turn, then tired in the drive. FLORIDA GAL bumped with PRIMETIME PRINCESS racing into the first turn, tracked the pace four wide, then was steadied from close quarters on the far turn and faltered. HOME BEFOR MIDNITE rated off the pace, steadied in traffic on the far turn and had no response when asked. UNFAIR vied for the lead along the hedge to the top of the stretch, then faded. TINKERBUCK vied for the lead outside UNFAIR, then was steadied from tight quarters at the top of the stretch and stopped.
