CRAFTY TOAST reserved early, angled out top stretch, rallied to gain a slim lead at the eighth pole and was all out to prevail. SWEEP MACHINE stalked the pace, drew even approaching the eighth and continued on gamely while being edged to the wire. A PENNY SAVED wearing a nasal strip, raced four wide on the turn and rallied mildly to best the others. B. K.'S NOTEBOOK saved ground while advancing into contention in midstretch, then tired. GRAND VERANDA steadied from tight quarters at the start and was outrun. WRONG DELIVERY showed early foot and faltered. SAMANTHA THE GREAT showed speed along the inside and faded.
