Footnotes

OLD FORESTER stalked the pace three wide, rallied to take over inside the eighth pole and was under a strong hand ride to prevail. ECCLESIASTIC tracked the pace along the rail into the stretch and continued on gamely for the place while being edged to the wire. NEW SCIENCE set the pace along the inside to midstretch and weakened. MORE BOURB unhurried early, raced three wide on the far turn, swung out for the stretch run and closed with a belated rally. WILCOX RIDGE vied for the lead outside NEW SCIENCE to midstretch, then gave way. COCKLESHELL reserved after breaking slowly, saved ground, was steadied in behind the leaders in the stretch and couldn't gain late. POLO GROUNDS raced in striking position into the stretch and had no late response. QUACKERS APPEAL rated off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn and lacked a rally. NIGHTMARE AFFAIR was not a factor. SILVERSANDSOFTIME trailed.
