OH SAY CAN YOU RUN chased the winner along the rail into the stretch but was no match for that rival while continuing on with good courage for the place. PITCH A PENNY reserved off the pace after breaking slowly, angled out for the drive and closed to be up for the show. HALO JAMERICA saved ground and failed to menace. INRIGHTCLASSITIME chased the leaders around the turn and tired. BOBBIE'S CONCERTA off slowly, raced three wide and trailed.
