Footnotes

THE JUDGE SEZ WHO unhurried while saving ground, angled outside the leaders on the far turn, rallied to catch BEST OF THE REST in early stretch, then edged away from that rival late under pressure. BEST OF THE REST stumbled at the start, stalked the pace four wide, moved to gain a slim lead just past midway of the far turn, responded when headed by THE JUDGE SEZ WHO in early stretch but couldn't stay with that rival late. DANCING GUY rated off the pace, raced four wide around the far turn, then drifted out through the stretch while gaining the show. BOOKLET always close up while racing three wide, moved to gain a brief lead on the far turn, then tired in the drive. WOODMOON vied for the lead outside COOL N COLLECTIVE, moved to the inside when that rival dropped back on the far turn, then faltered. SIR BEAR was outrun. COOL N COLLECTIVE vied for the lead along the inside to the far turn and faded. HIGH IDEAL raced three wide and was never a factor.
