**Footnotes**

HIGH SPEED ACCESS unhurried early, swung out for the stretch run and rallied under pressure to be just up at the wire. SPARKLING HUMOR tracked the pace along the rail, slipped through inside STORMY KITTY to take over inside the eighth pole, then just failed to last. PRESENT DANGER rated off the pace, angled out for the stretch run and closed to be up for the show while being outfinished by the winner. R OBSESSION reserved off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn and closed with a mild rally. RIGHT THIS WAY outrun after hitting the gate at the start, swung wide for the stretch run and gained ground late. OLD FASHION GIRL stalked the pace, moved to gain a brief lead in the stretch, then gave way. TOP HILL allowed to settle, gained some ground in the drive without threatening. MARINA DE CHAVON saved ground and lacked a late response. STORMY KITTY set the pace along the inside to midstretch and tired. OUTRAGEOUS QUEEN chased the pace into the far turn, then faltered.
