STAKES Frances A. Genter S. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOR FILLIES, THREE YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$100 each which shall accompany the nomination, \$1,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,000 to start - with \$100,000 guaranteed. The Owner of the winner to receive \$60,000, \$20,000 to second, \$11,000 to third, \$6,000 to fourth and \$3,000 to fifth. Weight: 121 lbs. Non-winners of \$35,000 twice or \$35,000 on the turf at a mile or over allowed 3 lbs.; \$35,000 or three races other than Maiden, Claiming, or Starter, 5 lbs.; a race other than Maiden, Claiming or Starter, 7 lbs. If this race is taken off the turf, only main track wins will determine allowances. Graded placed horses of equal weights preferred. Graded stakes winners preferred. Lifetime turf earnings used to prefer horses of equal weight. A trophy will be presented to the winning Owner. This race will be limited to 12 Starters, with Also Eligibles (High Weights Preferred). Closed Saturday, December 16, 2006 with (36) nominations. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the Turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile).

Footnotes

BAYOU'S LASSIE rated the pace toward the inside, was pressured into the lane, dug in hard through the final furlong and just lasted. J'RAY, slow into stride, settled back saving ground, made her bid midway on the final turn, skimmed the hedge entering the stretch, closed to the winner in deep stretch and just missed in a game effort. AMANSARA rated off the pace and off the hedge, started her drive entering the stretch and finished well but needed more. SILVERSIDER rated just off the early pace inside, came out making her bid entering the stretch then leveled off toward the wire. RASTA FARIAN rated off the pace toward mid track, advanced six wide on the final turn and finished evenly. MISS SHOP, unhurried off the hedge, bid into the lane and finished well. DANCING BAND steadied on the heels of Fray into the opening turn, settled unhurriedly on the backstretch, bid widest through the final turn and finished evenly. GOOD INTENTIONS saved ground early, eased out on the final turn and had no rally. PROSPECT OF LOVE rated close just off the rail after a short brief early lead then gave way in the stretch. SCARLETT'S PRIDE (FR) rated off the pace between horses early, bid mildly into the final turn then faded in the lane. PEAK MARIA'S WAY rated off the early pace about the four path, gave chase into the final turn then weakened in the stretch.
