SLEWS FINAL ANSWER rated off the pace, angled outside the leaders leaving the turn, rallied to take over at the eighth pole and drew clear under a hand ride. WISH IT WERE up close early along the rail, dropped back racing around the turn, angled out for the drive and closed to be up for the show. TCHULA MISS vied for the lead three wide around the turn, then weakened in the drive and was just edged for the place. FOUR PENNIES vied for the lead between horses into the stretch and gave way. PHARMSTAR failed to menace. BLUE CREEK off slowly, was outrun. SEA SPAN vied for the lead along the inside into the stretch and tired. GIST raced four wide on the turn and faltered.
