WIMAUMA MAMA forced the pace from the inside, gained the lead in the upper stretch, held clear under a strong drive. SKIP SCHOOL prompted the pace three wide, dropped to the rail around the turn to have aim but hung. TUFTON AVENUE advanced five wide down the backstretch, angled down three wide on the turn, finished willingly. T. V. SECRETARY stalked the pace three and four wide, failed to respond. ALPINE SINGER close up on the rail, had no rally. REPLINKA never threatened four wide. LOCKET failed to menace on the rail. MISS INDEPENDENT was used up after a half three wide. JOHN'SBIRTHDAYGIRL set the pace for a half under heavy pressure, stopped.
