Footnotes

EVENING CONCERTO stalked the pace three wide the opening turn, assumed a slim lead past the seven sixteenths pole, contested a slight disadvantage on the final turn but dug in gamely to recover control a furlong away and moved clear the closing yards. SQUABBLE rated with the pace inside, contested the rail on the final turn then dueled at the withers of the winner to the sixteenth pole before weakening. DANCE WITH BUTTERS showed no speed early, bid mildly about the three path on the final turn but leveled off through the lane. TEXAS GLITZ showed no early speed about the four path, saved ground making a mild bid on the final turn then leveled off in the stretch. LITIGATION, unhurried, bid into the final turn and passed some fading rivals. ONYOURMARQGETSETGO, with the early pace two deep, faded toward the final turn. MAJOR RICK was standing splayed in the gate and bobbed at the break. UNBRUSH never factored.
