WINDSOR'S SECRET bobbled a stride out, stalked the pace inside, dueled to the lead nearing the quarter pole, raced clear on the final turn and dug in gamely to the challenge of the runner-up to retain his edge. GHOSTLY THUNDER settled well back toward mid track, bid leaving the half mile pole, steadily gained while saving some ground approaching the final turn, rounded the turn three wide, took aim in the upper stretch and finished well at the withers of the winner. SPIRITWOOD settled well back off the rail, bid leaving the three eighths pole, circled four wide on the final turn then leveled off in late stretch. HE'S A HOBBY settled off the early pace inside and ran evenly off the rail rounding the final turn. BEAU AMERICAN was outrun. FIRST AND BAY settled back about the four path then faded nearing the final turn. NICOLES PROSPECT rated a slim lead two deep, came under pressure at the five sixteenths pole then faded on the final turn. IMITATION OF LIFE, well back inside, was through after a half mile.
